1. WHAT ARE COOKIES?

A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that we store on your browser or the hard drive of your computer if you agree. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive.

Cookies are useful because they allow a website to recognise a user's device. Cookies allow you to navigate between pages efficiently, remember preferences, and generally improve the overall user experience. Cookies can also be used to tailor advertising to your interests through tracking your browsing across websites.

2. HOW CAN COOKIES BE DISABLED?

You can block cookies by activating the setting on your browser that allows you to refuse the setting of all or some cookies. However, if you use your browser settings to block all cookies (including essential cookies) you may not be able to access all or parts of our Website or Services. If you do not agree to the use of these cookies, please disable them by following the instructions for your browser set out here.

Some browsers make it possible for you to select that you do not want your internet browsing activity to be tracked. Disabling tracking may interfere with some functions of the Website and Services.

We may change the cookies we use after your initial visit to our Website and use of our Services. This Policy will always allow you to know who is placing cookies, for what purpose such cookies are being placed, as well as give you the means to disable cookies.

3. WHAT TYPES OF COOKIES DO WE USE?

• Necessary Cookies: These cookies are essential in order to enable you to move around the

- website and use its features or are required by law. Without these cookies, services you have asked for (such as navigating between pages) cannot be provided. Further, these cookies ensure we are able to deliver you information and services securely and optimally.
- Performance Cookies: We make use of analytical cookies to analyse how our visitors use our Website and to monitor Website performance. This allows us to customise our offerings and quickly identify and fix any issues that may arise so as to create a high-quality user experience. For example, we might use performance cookies to keep track of which pages are most popular, which method of linking between pages is most effective, and to determine why some pages cause error messages. We might also use these cookies to highlight articles or services that we think will be of interest to you based on your usage of the Website. Unless expressly stated below, the information collected by these cookies is not associated with your personal information by us or by our contractors.
- <u>Functionality Cookies</u>: We make use of cookies to provide you with certain functionality. For
 example, we will use cookies to remember information unique to you such as your login
 credentials, language and region, and to recognise the platform from which you access the
 Website, as well as to personalise certain features. These cookies are not used to track your
 browsing on other websites.
- Advertising Cookies: Advertising (or targeting) cookies collect information about the browsing habits associated with your device and are used to make advertising more relevant to you and your interests. They are also used by services provided by third parties on this Website and our Services, such as 'Like' or 'Share' buttons in addition to providing the requested functionality. - <u>Use of IP Addresses and Web Logs</u>: We may also use your IP address and browser type to assist with diagnosis of problems with our server, to administer our Website and to improve the services we offer to you. An IP address is a numeric code that identifies your computer on the internet. Your IP address might also be used to gather broad demographic information. We may perform IP lookups to determine which domain you are coming from (for example, a link from a search engine) in order to more accurately gauge our users' demographics.
