THE HISTORY OF THE GAY GAMES

he spirit of Sport celebrates the body and mind, embodied by values such as excellence in performance, teamwork, commitment, and fairplay. In Sport, we are all equal, what matters is our commitment to achieving excellence.

First founded in San Francisco in 1982, the Gay Games Hong Kong took place from 3-11 November 2023, for the first time in Asia. There are 18 sporting events planned including new events Dragon Boat Racing, Mahjong, and Trail Running; Opening & Closing Ceremonies, Festival Village, and Arts & Culture events with daily performances, a Gala Concert, LGBTQ+ art exhibitions, and a variety of events to celebrate the 40th anniversary of the Gay Games.

Everyone is welcome to participate regardless of ethnicity, religion, age, sexual orientation, gender identity, ability, or background.

Gay Games 11 Hong Kong 2023's unique combination of sport, arts, culture, fun and community brought together diverse groups of people from all over the world to converge on Hong Kong in 2023.

Under the theme of "Unity In Diversity", the Games aim to promote unity and inclusion to help Hong Kong truly live up to its potential as a world-class city.



### **NEW SPORTS THIS YEAR**

Hosting the first Games to take place in Asia is not only an honor, but also a great chance for us to celebrate some of the unique sports which have come out of this part of the world.



#### **DRAGON BOAT RACING**

Dragon boat races originated over a thousand years ago in the Lingnan region of China, where people believed the water that passed through dragon boat oars was a great fortune, but the modern version of the races actually began in 1976 in Hong Kong.



#### **LIGHTSPEED SABER**

This new category of fencing is the world's fastest light-based fencing - think 'Star Wars meets fencing'. The sabers glow in the dark and make sounds as you thrust them at the opponent. It is an athletic & intense spectator sport and a lot of fun too - don't miss it.



#### **MAHJONG**

Developed in the 19th century in China, Mahjong is one of the world's most-played games with over 350 million players in Asia alone. Walking through the neighborhoods of Hong Kong, the game is everywhere you look and you'll hear the click-clack of mahjong tiles echoing through the shops and homes.

We have also added two other new sports which are gaining in popularity internationally and are a welcome addition to our lineup.

#### TRAIL RUNNING

Hong Kong's spectacular scenery of waving green hills, rugged cliffs and gorgeous bays filled with picturesque islands, makes it a popular location among nature-loving hikers — and trail runners. It's one of the best places on earth to trail run





#### **DODGEBALL**

Despite its somewhat aggressive reputation, Dodgeball has been growing in popularity especially amongst the LGBTQ+ community. It has now become an extremely inclusive sport that celebrates diversity and is often played with mixed genders. We are very excited to add this fast- paced and intense sport to our list of competitive events

ince the first Cay Games, commemorative events relating to HIV/AIDS have always played a significant role in representing the endowments of the Games. GGHK is honored to hold the AIDS Quilt Memorial Ceremony as the first official event to kick start Gay Games in Hong Kong.

A special quilt has been created for this memorial service to commemorate people who have passed away from AIDS-related illnesses. Participants of the memorial moment may sign with dedication messages on the quilt.

Through this ceremony and quilt exhibition, we hope to raise awareness about HIV/AIDS, break down stereotypes towards HIV/AIDS and increase public knowledge on HIV/AIDS prevention.





FEE WAIVER

he Fee Waiver Program offered by GGHK Funding Support provides an opportunity for individuals in Hong Kong to participate in sports and performing arts without the burden of registration and participation fees. This program aims to empower the community and create positive change by allowing individuals to pursue their passions and contribute to the development of Hong Kong.

We were able to remove financial barriers for 176 individuals across 16 sports from diverse backgrounds have equal access to sports and performing arts. This was spread across individual and team sports, accumulated total of HK\$248,700 fee waived. The notable uptake of Dragonboat with 74 participants and Football with 17 participants in the Fee Waiver Program reflects certain trends and highlights the impact of the program on overcoming financial barriers.

1. Team Sports and Financial Barriers: Team sports, such as Dragonboat and Football, often have higher financial barriers compared to individual sports. This is because participation in team sports requires the collective contribution of the entire team to cover

registration fees and other expenses. By waiving the fees for these team sports, the program has effectively removed a significant financial hurdle.

2. Increased Accessibility: The high participation in Dragonboat and Football indicates that the fee waiver enabled individuals who may have otherwise been deterred by financial constraints to engage in these team sports. The program's provision of financial support has made it more accessible for individuals who are passionate about these sports but may not have had the means to participate previously.

3. Promoting Inclusivity: By removing financial barriers, the Fee Waiver Program has fostered inclusivity within Dragonboat and Football. It has created opportunities for individuals from diverse backgrounds. regardless of their financial situation, to join these sports teams and actively participate. This inclusivity enriches the team dynamics, promotes diversity, and strengthens the overall sports community.

4. Community Building: Dragonboat and Football are popular team sports that foster camaraderie, teamwork, and a sense of belonging. By supporting a larger number of participants in these sports, the Fee Waiver Program has not only enhanced individual experiences but also contributed to community building. It has created a platform for individuals to form connections, build relationships, and foster a supportive sports community.

#### 5. Encouraging Overall Sports Engagement:

The significant uptake in Dragonboat and Football suggests that the Fee Waiver Program has successfully encouraged overall sports engagement. By providing financial relief, the program has motivated individuals to actively participate in these team sports, promoting a healthier and more active lifestyle among the community. This initiative not only promotes inclusivity but also recognizes the importance of sports and performing arts in personal growth, community building, and fostering a sense of belonging. By offering these opportunities, GGHK Funding Support is encouraging individuals to embrace their passions, pursue their dreams, and contribute to a vibrant and dynamic Hong Kong.

The Fee Waiver Program is available on a firstcome, first-serve basis, and a dedicated fund has been allocated to support this initiative. Participants who meet the eligibility criteria will have their general registration fee and sports participation fee waived. There are threecategories of individuals who can benefit from this program.

- 1. Individuals between the ages of 18-25 as of November 3, 2023. These individuals will be eligible to receive the fee waiver during the specified dates of 3-11 November 2023
- 2. Foreign domestic workers who are 18 years of age or older and hold a valid Hong Kong SAR work permit
- 3. Asylum seekers who are 18 years of age or older and are under non-refoulement protection or have formally filed for such protection in Hong Kong SAR at the time of registration
